Countdown to JK Registration!

Starting Kindergarten is an exciting and special time for parents and children. Our entire school community looks forward to welcoming our youngest students as they begin a lifelong journey of faith-filled learning. We believe there is something truly unique and special about learning that is rooted in faith and spiritual growth. By choosing a faith-filled education, we know you share that belief with us.

Parents with children who are eligible to start school in September (turning 4 years old by December 31, 2017) are encouraged to call the school to be placed on our registration list. A package would then be sent home with a sibling who is already at the school. On Monday, February 6, a package will be sent home with a sibling who is already at school. Parents new to the school can come by the office, beginning February 6, to pick up the registration package. The following documents are needed to register your child: child's birth certificate, immunization record, child or parent's baptismal certificate, current house tax assessment form and proof of address (current utility bill). We are here to answer any questions and help you prepare. Please contact us at 289-231-2085 for more information and to reserve your package.

If your child is going to be either LATE or ABSENT from school for any reason, please call the school BEFORE 8:30am and leave a message on our 24-hour answering machine: (289) 231-2085 option 5.

When dropping off your child in the morning, please use the "Kiss 'n Ride" north entrance.

Supervisors will greet your child(ren) and will assist them out of the vehicle and escort them to their appropriate yard.

Please do not park and leave your vehicle running to drop off your child or pass another vehicle in the "Kiss 'n Ride" loop.

At 3:00, the "Kiss 'n Ride" entrance will be CLOSED.

We must all work together to ensure the safety of all our students.

Bicycles, Scooters and Skateboards On School Property

Students who ride their bikes, scooters, or skateboards to and from school are reminded to walk them when on school property. Students must also wear a helmet - it's the law!

If you will be moving or have moved recently, please let the school know as soon as possible so that we can update your child's file. Also, if you have other information such as phone numbers or new medical emergency information for your child, please contact the office.

Arriving At School On Time

Just a reminder to parents and students of the importance of arriving at school on time each and every day. By arriving on time, students develop a crucial life skill that will serve them well in their futures. Students are also less anxious about coming to school because they are involved in social interactions with their peers before the start of school. Students who arrive late, miss this important aspect of daily school life. In addition to feeling responsible for disrupting the class when they arrive, they have to wait for a moment when the teacher (or DECE in our Kindergarten classes) is free to get the child caught up.

If you find you are arriving consistently late, please adjust your schedule so you arrive on time. Plan for a slower Kiss N' Ride drop off on rainy days (or worse, on snowy days).
