school-day - Online Payments & Forms

We have exciting news! Our school has been chosen to participate in a pilot project for the implementation of a new online payment and communication tool. The tool is called school-day and can be accessed from any webbrowser and gives parents real-time, secure access to up-to-date information.

Some benefits include the ability to:

- Receive email communications from your child's school (newsletters, etc)
- Approve permission forms on-line
- Register your child for extracurricular events
- Make online payments for sports fees, trips, hot lunches or other activities
- Update your mobile device with calendar events specific to your child
- Minimize the risks associated with sending money to school with your child ("backpack delivery") and
- Reduce the environmental impact of photocopying permission forms and announcements

Walk 'n' Wheel Wednesday "3.0" - May 10

In May 2016, St. Angela Merici was approached by the town's Active Transportation and Recreation Committee to help spearhead what has become an annual event. St. Angela had already experienced much success having had run several Walking Wednesdays in prior months and so, our school was a natural choice to help introduce this to the larger community.

In October 2016, the event grew to four schools and interest among other elementary schools has continued to grow so that a total of 9 elementary schools will be participating this year.

Councillor Baynes, chair of the Active Transportation and Recreation Committee mentions that, "The original two key objectives have not changed at all. We want to encourage students of all ages to be active, and walking to School is a great starting point that we hope becomes a regular activity just not something that is done on a special event day. And the second objective happens automatically (or is it automagically in this case) as a result ... there is way less traffic congestion near and right at the Schools. Promoting active living while at the same time increasing safety near Schools. A double win for sure, concludes Baynes".

After your walk or wheel to school on May 10th, look for the canopy tent and table that will be set up, where staff, including Mr. Warman from the Town and Officer Elisabeth from South Simcoe Police, will greet you and celebrate your efforts by handing out "I Walk to School" ribbons. Canadian Tire is also supporting this event by donating to each participating school two bike helmets to be raffled off at a later time!

I encourage all of our parents and students to join us on May 10th for what will be a wonderful event.

Catholic Education Week

Using these resources as well as our own developed activities, we have prepared a series of activities which will highlight how our school is 'Walking Forward Together.'

Dual Language Book Writing Project

On April 19th, Christine Ignas and Gillian Montgomery, together with Ms. DeFreitas, supported students and parents create dual-language books. In attendance were two parents who helped their children create some great books. Older students partnered with younger students to help with the writing of their home language. Students were talking about and comparing their languages and knowledge of language through the day. All students worked very diligently to get their books done - mostly independently. One grade 3 student even did an ebook in Explain Everything at the very end of the day since she spoke Assyrian, which is not typically a written language.

Thank you to Ms DeFreitas, Ms. Montgomery, Ms. Ignas and Richard Newton for all their help and patience through the day - especially getting the younger students set up with Google Accounts and using the Google Slides template. And thank you to Mrs. Ellis for being so accommodating and sharing the library (and opening the chapel) with more than 20 people all day.

The books now go off to the printer and soon, students will receive their professional-looking literary creations. Awesome!
