## MATHEMATICS AND STUDENT'S DAILY EXPERIENCES

Working with children to help them discover mathematics in their daily lives is an excellent way for families to enjoy mathematics together. We are introducing "MATH CORNER" as part of our The Week Ahead communication. We will share ideas and suggestions from the Guides to Effective Instruction in Mathematics that parents can explore together with their children, particularly as a way of following up on concepts that are being taught in the classroom.

- Encourage explorative math play at home (e.g., invite your child to build, measure, and compare structures made with different-sized cardboard boxes; build and describe structures in a sandbox; play jump-rope games or games like hopscotch, catch, and hide-and-seek).
