### **DRESS CODE**

#### Kiss and Ride

Parents using the Kiss and Ride are reminded to remain in their vehicles, allowing staff to help students exit the vehicle safely. Once students have been safely unloaded and are on the sidewalk, parents are asked to continue driving in line, waiting their turn to leave the Kiss and Ride. Pylons are in place to remind drivers that **passing cars in line is not permitted**. For everyone's safety, kindly wait patiently until you reach the front of the line and then exit the Kiss and Ride.
