

Halloween is just around the corner. Students are welcome to dress up in a costume on Thursday, October 31st. For safety reasons, we ask the following rules be followed:

- absolutely no masks (full or partial)
- any required make-up must be applied at home. Do not bring make-up or fragrances to school
- spray cans/products of any kind (hair, colour, fragrances, etc.) are not permitted
- all costume accessories such as pitch forks, swords and other weapons, etc. are to remain at home

In addition, the school's dress code must be followed. Please refer to the "Appropriate Dress Guidelines" in your child's agenda. Students not wishing to dress up are encouraged to wear black and orange to show their School Spirit.

Please note that the Kindergarten Costume Parade is for students only.
