## School Bus Evacuation Training

The Simcoe County Student Transportation Consortium (SCSTC), in partnership with our School Bus Operator, Switzer-Carty, will conduct School Bus Evacuation Training to all home-to-school transported students. School bus drivers will be educating students on how to evacuate a school bus safely in an emergency situation. This program is a follow-up to the training that was provided during School Bus Safety Week in October 2018. This training will occur during regular morning transportation once the bus arrives with the students at the school. After the training has been completed by the bus driver, students will disembark from the bus.

Training provided by the school bus driver will:

- confirm that the school bus driver is in charge during an evacuation situation;
- identify how to evacuate the school bus safely by using the front door, rear door, and both doors simultaneously, as well as other evacuation options;
- identify that students are to move away from the bus to a safe location designated by the driver following an evacuation.

On April 6, 2018, Canadians were heartbroken to hear the news of the Humboldt Broncos bus crash. Of the 29 passengers, sixteen lost their lives and thirteen will all bear physical and emotional scars for life.

On April 7, 2018, Humboldt Broncos defenceman, Logan Boulet succumbed to his injuries, his parents, Bernadine and Toby Boulet offered to donate his organs so that six lives could live on. They did so, because Logan told his parents, he was registering as an organ donor, and that he was inspired by his coach and mentor Ric Suggitt.
